RE: ZERO EMISSION VEHICLE DECLARATION - NIGERIA

The Nigeria National Council on Climate Change (NCCC) notes the COP26 declaration on accelerating the transition to 100% zero emission cars and vans that aims to accelerate the transition to zero emission vehicles to achieve the goals of the Paris Agreement.

At COP28, Nigeria's President indicated his administration's support for the transition to zero emission transport systems by announcing the purchase of 100 e-buses, as a first step in this process.

The NCCC confirms that transportation is a priority sector and that the goal of this declaration supports Nigeria's climate and national development aspirations as declared in various national documents such as the Netzero Target of 2060, Nationally Determined Contributions, Energy Transition Plan and Long-Term Low Emission Development Strategies, among others.
